GP Pensions administration is now managed through PCSE Online.

As a principal GP or practice manager, you can now search, filter and view Additional Voluntary Contributions through PCSE Online.




If you are looking to stop, amend or add additional voluntary contributions to your pension scheme, you will need to contact NHS Pensions directly and discuss your requirements with them. They will agree with you the AVC type, amount and duration and then send this to our PCSE Pensions team to process.


To use this guide, your user administrator needs to ensure you have been set up in PCSE Online with at least one of the following roles:

Where can I view AVCs?


If you want to view your own Additional Voluntary contributions, or if you are a practice manager who wishes to view a principal GPs AVCs. You will need to:


- Log in PCSE Online

If you are a principal GP, your AVCs will be pre-populated in the table below.


Click on the magnifying glass icons to see more and then click Next.






Where can I view AVCs?
